

Friday Ski Club Procedures. Name _____

Itinerary

12:30 pm – You may begin arriving at the school

12:55 pm – Take attendance - Everyone should be on the bus, with the trailer loaded

1:00 pm – The bus and trailer will leave, even if you are pulling in the parking lot

2:00 pm – Arrive at Pomerelle, unload the trailer, go through the rental line, get classes organized

3:00 pm – Lessons will begin (about 1 hour or so long)

You can eat anytime after your lesson until 8:30 when they shut off the grill

5:00 to 9:00 pm – Cleaning jobs for those assigned (5-10 minutes)

8:59 pm – Last chance to get on the lift for the final run of the evening

9:00 pm to 9:20 pm – Load the trailer and bus

9:15 pm – *All rental equipment must be checked in by this time!*

9:25 pm – Attendance taken and leave the mountain

10:05 pm – Arrive at East Minico if the roads are good

10:40 pm – All students should be picked up and gone

The times in red may be modified next week if we find that we are arriving too early. We will give you updated times next week if necessary.

1. **What to bring:** Equipment (Skis, board, boots and poles); **warm coat, pants, gloves**, goggles, and hand\toe warmers. Bring a sack lunch or money for dinner (\$15 is usually enough). Bring hygiene items, your inhaler, Tylenol, or any other medicine you might need. We cannot give you medicine for any reason. We also suggest sun screen – yes, we may be skiing in the sun!
2. **Let me reiterate that it can get VERY cold at Pomerelle at night.** Do not forget the stuff above!
3. Lunch boxes are the only things that may be taken into the lodge. All other items should be left in the ski trailer.
4. **What not to bring:** Anything you cannot afford to lose! Things DO get stolen and we cannot do much about that. Don't drop your phone off the lift! Lockers are available for rent in the lodge.
5. **You must ride the bus back with us.** You may not ride back with brothers, sisters, parents, etc without a signed note from a parent, or them personally talking to me.
6. Make sure you have photos of your equipment. Put your name on EVERYTHING! Skis and boards should be in bags. We are NOT responsible for any damage to your equipment.
7. **Students DO NOT load equipment into the truck or trailer.** Only adults may do that.
8. No bouncing the lift, leaving trash on the runs or in the lodge, throwing things or spitting off the lift, or skiing on runs that are closed (once they turn the lights on, you may only go on the runs with lights). I don't care if the President of the USA himself tells you it is OK to ski on a closed run; you WILL be terminated from the program if you do.
9. Always say "Please" and "Thank You!" to any Pomerelle employees and teachers\adults.
10. School rules on affection will be strictly enforced.
11. **Parents MUST be at the school by 10:05 p.m.** Call them when we get to Declo to come get you. DO NOT wait to call them when you get to the school!
12. Go back and re-read your signup packet. Failure to remember the rules will not be a valid excuse should you break one of the rules. Anyone who is terminated from the program will most likely not be invited to return next year either, whether you will still be at East, or at Minico (Yes, we will tell them...)

Arriving at school

Students should arrive wearing as much of their ski clothing as possible – backpacks and bulky items will NOT be allowed on the bus since each seat will have three students in it and we simply do not have space for such items. These items will be required to be left in the trailer.

Truck & Trailer Location: Do not park in front of the school in the area from far North end of the auditorium to the flagpole – this is the bus and trailer parking area.

1. Parents MUST pull into a parking spot – DO NOT stop in the driveway and block traffic!

Loading the trailer, RFID cards and school badges

1. Bring your equipment to whomever is loading the trailer and let them stack it neatly for you.
2. You cannot have backpacks or ski bags on the bus (too crowded), put these in the trailer.
3. RFID cards and badges will be on the lunch table in front of the school.
4. An adult will be the table to take attendance and will have the bus seating chart.
5. Get on the bus and find your assigned seat.

On the bus ride to Pomerelle

1. Do not stand up or hop from seat to seat or you will be done skiing at 8 p.m. No exceptions!
2. Keep the visiting at a regular volume. Anyone who is too loud will be a bus cleaner.
3. Anything that can blind the bus driver such as cell phone LCD screens, laser pointers, glow sticks or other such stuff will be confiscated. This is especially true on the way home when it's dark.

At Pomerelle

1. Get off the bus and help unload the trailer if necessary – DO NOT just stand there “looking” – then get your things.
 - a. **Renters:** Get your things, leaving anything that does NOT need to go to the lodge in the trailer. Go directly to the rental room in the basement of the lodge. Have your RFID ready.
 - b. **Non-Renters:** Get your things. Put all your bags and other things back in the trailer – no bags may be taken in the lodge unless you rent a locker.
2. EVERYONE then meets at the big bell AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!
3. Anyone late to a lesson because you are “waiting for a friend” who is renting, in the bathroom, daydreaming, etc. will lose 1 hour of skiing and will be done at 8:00 PM!
4. During your lesson: Do what your instructor asks you to do AND be polite. Say please and thank you! If any instructor is not acting professional in any way you will need to let Mr. Larson know!
5. After your lesson, you may eat dinner and ski the rest of the night. Be safe and report accidents to Mr. Larson no matter how small you think it might be. Spend as little time as possible inside.
6. The night you are assigned to clean the lodge at dinner time you need to be between the times marked on your cleaning ticket. Check in with Mr. Larson before and after your cleaning duty so he can mark you off the list. Pick up trash, cups, trays off the tables and floor. You do not have to wipe the tables.
7. You may not get on the lift after 9:00 p.m. You must be off the mountain at 9:15 p.m. and on the bus at 9:25 p.m. The Bus leaves at 9:30 p.m. sharp! DO NOT BE LATE!

Bus ride home:

1. See the rules above labeled “On the bus ride to Pomerelle”
2. Bus cleaners stay and clean.
3. Get off the bus and tell Mr. Heath thank you for driving. Help unload the bus if necessary.
4. Get your equipment and find your parents. Tell your parents thank you for picking you up. Go home, go to bed, sleep in, then clean your room 😊.
